Introduction

The Revised State Drug List (SDL) for Meghalaya is designed for the effective management and distribution of pharmaceuticals across healthcare facilities within the state. Recognizing the dynamic nature of healthcare needs and the imperative to optimize medication access, this revision seeks to refine the selection and availability of essential Drugs systematically. As a crucial tool, the SDL aims to enhance patient outcomes, foster cost-effectiveness, and support the sustainability of healthcare services in Meghalaya, ensuring equitable access to essential medications for all population segments.

The methodology employed to revise the SDL involved a detailed extraction and analysis of data from existing state health documents, drug usage reports, and input from healthcare professionals through Focus Group Discussions (FGDs). Each medication was rigorously assessed for its therapeutic value, historical consumption data across various health facilities, and alignment with the Indian Public Health Standards (IPHS) 2022. This structured approach facilitated a robust categorization of drugs by therapeutic class, usage frequency, and necessity, underpinning the revisions with a data-driven foundation designed to meet the state's current and future health priorities.

The revised SDL is organized into multiple tables, each representing a specific drug category and therapeutic class, to provide clarity and ease of access. The tables include detailed listings of drug names, dosage forms, strengths, categories based on therapeutic need, IPHS compliance, consumption patterns, and designated priority. This format ensures that healthcare providers can quickly reference and use the necessary medications, optimizing the delivery of care.

The revised SDL adheres strictly to the guidelines prescribed by the IPHS 2022, ensuring national relevance. This alignment guarantees that drug selection is based on the best available evidence and tailored to the specific health challenges and demographic needs of Meghalaya. The compliance with these standards not only elevates the quality of healthcare but also ensures consistency and equity in the availability of essential drugs across the state.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE EDL

1. The Committee recommended that all Drugs provided in health facilities under the State initiative and National Health Programs be considered essential Drugs.
2. The strength and dose of each drugs have been specified.
3. Drugs have been categorized and indicated for specific facilities, including DH, CHC, PHC, and SHC-HWC, based on their essentiality.
4. SDL consists of a total of 390 Drugs.
5. Total Drugs Facility-Wise:

6. The list of essential Drugs will guide hospital drug policies and the procurement and supply of Drugs in the public sector.
7. The list serves as a document for prescribing the correct dosage form and strength, with preference given to single drug formulations. Using the SDL is expected to improve prescribing practices by promoting the use of generic names.
8. The appropriate use of Drugs selected in the SDL promotes rational use of Drugs.
9. The list also serves as a reference for assessing the healthcare access of the population.
10. Lastly, the SDL serves as a tool for training healthcare providers.
11. These salient features of the SDL aim to ensure the availability, appropriate use, and accessibility of essential Drugs, ultimately improving healthcare outcomes and patient care.

Regarding drugs that were not marked up to SC, might be obtained from the PHC upon endorsement and prescription from the relevant MO.
